In 1086 in the Domesday Book Piddletrenthide was recorded as Pidrie; it had 70 households, 17 ploughlands, 16 acres (6.5 ha) of meadow, three mills and a taxable value of 30 geld units. It was in Cerne, Totcombe and Modbury Hundred and the tenant-in-chief was Winchester Abbey . [3]

It was referred to as "Wallop Inferior" in the Domesday book and sits on the banks of Wallop Brook, which rises to the surface at nearby Over Wallop. The term Wallop itself comes from old words for stream (waella) and valley (hop). The Nether part of
