The term "textual poaching" was first developed by the French scholar Michel de Certeau in The Practise of Everyday Life (1984) and later developed by Henry Jenkins in Textual poachers: Television Fans and Participatory Culture (1992). De Certeau argues that audiences are not passive consumers but instead active interpreters. This follows Stuart Hall's encoding/decoding model of communication (1980) where each person will create their own meaning from the same text, depending on their ...
